## How to get to Ewha

### 1. From Incheon International Airport Terminal 1 or 2 to Ewha Womans University

- Subway (Travel time: Approximately 1 hour / 12 or 13 stops | 4,950 won)

Depart	Transfer	Arrive
Incheon Int'l Airport	Hongik Univ. ( <b>Airport Railroad Express</b> )	Ewha Womans Univ. ( <b>Line 2</b> )

- Board the Airport Railroad Express (all-stop train) at Incheon International Airport.
- Once you arrive at Hongik Univ. station, transfer to Line 2 of the Seoul Metropolitan Subway.
- Follow the signs to the subway platforms and board a train heading towards Sinchon.
- Get off the train at Ewha Womans University Station (Exit 2 or 3).
- Walk straight towards the main entrance of Ewha, which is a 10-minute walk from the station.

- Airport Shuttle Bus (Travel time: Approximately 1 hour 15 minutes | 17,000 won)

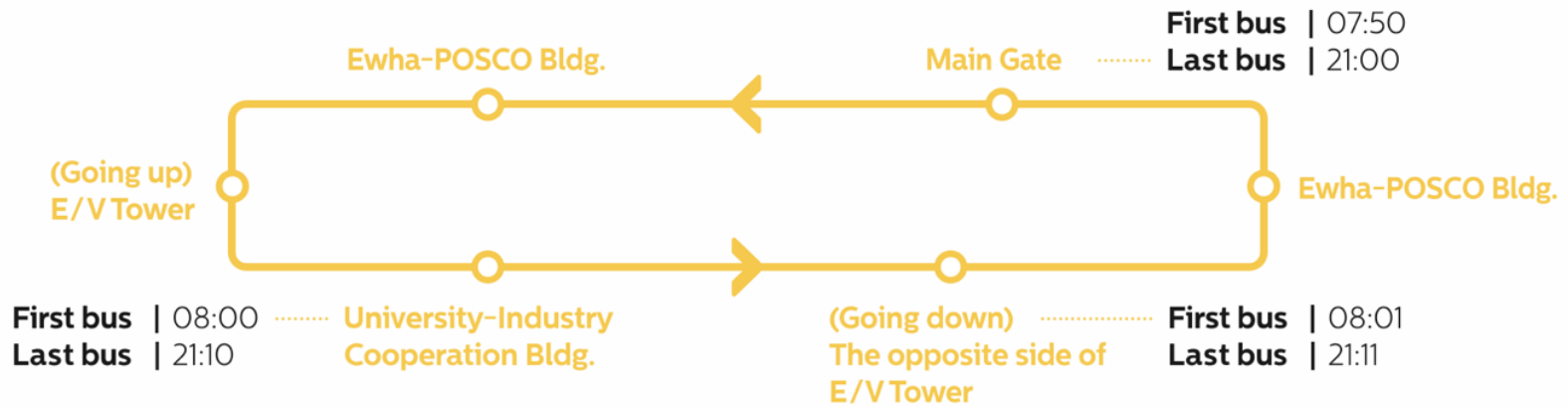
- Purchase tickets and get information at the bus ticket offices indoors (next to Exits 4 and 9) and outdoors (near Exits. 4, 6, 7, 8, 11 and 13). On the 1<sup>st</sup> floor of Passenger Terminal 1.
- Once the bus stops at Ewha Womans Univ. station, get off and walk towards the main entrance of Ewha.

### • Shuttle Bus

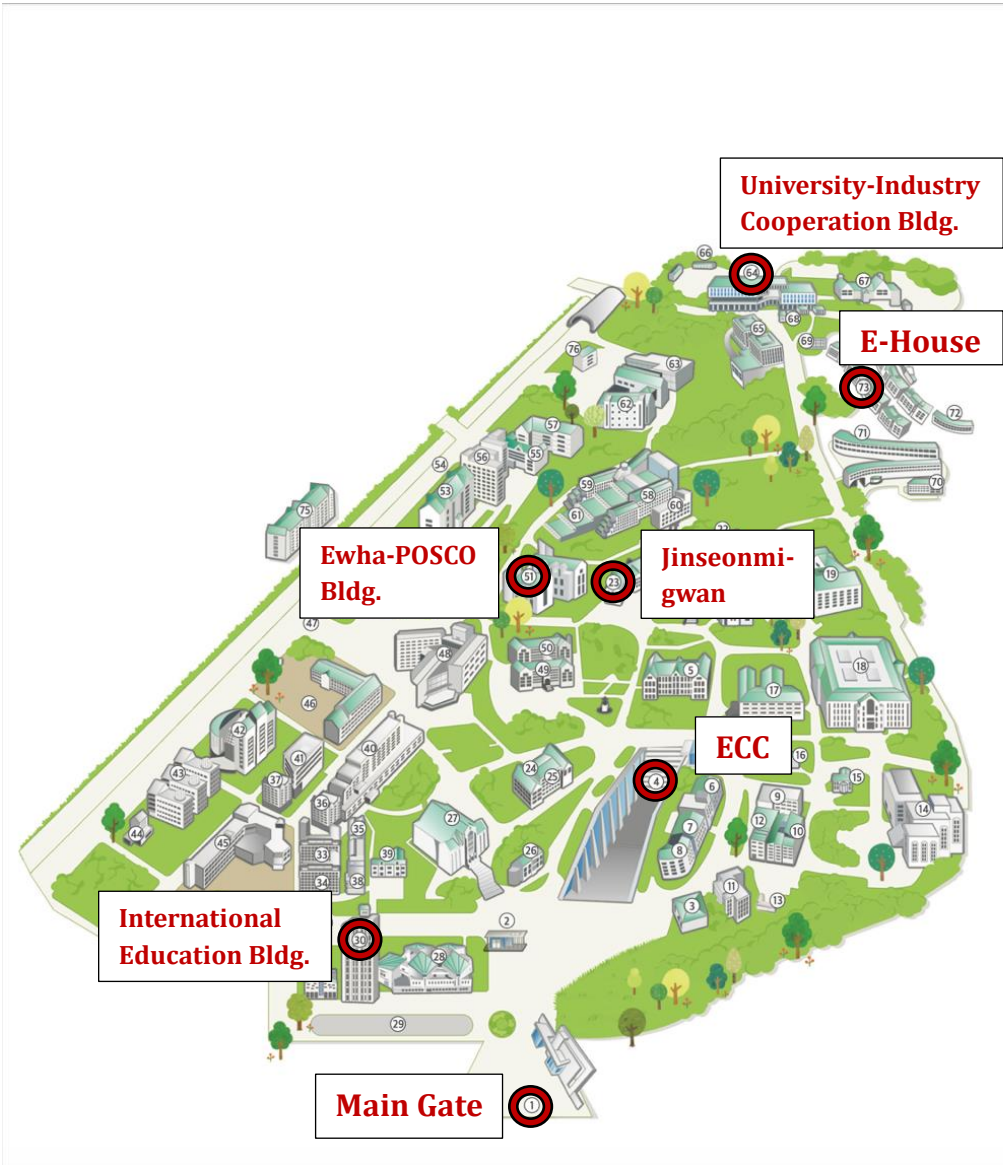
